

Foundation for Economic Education (“FEE”) is proud to produce FEEcon (“Events”). The following Registration and Credentials Terms and Conditions (“Terms”) apply to you and any party you are registering for participation in any FEEcon Events (“Participant”), and such Participant’s registration, attendance, participation, enrollment, and/or application for involvement in the Events, including but not limited to your purchase and/or possession of any FEE Event entry credentials, such as wristbands, badges, tickets and passes (collectively, “Credential(s)”). By clicking “accept” below, and/or by obtaining your Credentials you agree to these Terms.

1. FEE and its agents and representatives are the sole creators, sellers and distributors of FEE Credentials. Any Credential not created by and legally acquired from FEE or its authorized agents or representatives will be considered fraudulent and invalid, and subject to revocation. FEE reserves the right to pursue any and all legal action available against any person involved in the creation, dissemination or use of an unauthorized Credential.
2. Refund & Revocation Policy. All Credentials are the sole property of FEE. FEE may, in its sole discretion and at any time determined by FEE, cancel, revoke, or refuse from any individual or company the following: Credentials, purchases, and/or hotel reservations made through FEE. FEE will not be responsible for any penalty, fee, loss, or expense that might result from such action.
3. FEE Credentials are issued to, can be picked up by, and used by only the Participant named in the registration. FEE Credentials are non-transferable after they have been picked up. For security reasons, and to allow entry into an applicable FEEcon Event, each Participant must wear their Credential as follows: badges must be on the FEE-issued lanyard around Participant’s neck while participating in Events, and Wristbands must be securely affixed to the Participant’s wrist and remain on the Participant’s wrist throughout the FEEcon Event. No other laminates may be worn on the FEE lanyard for the badge to be valid. If a Credential is not worn correctly by Participant, FEE reserves the right to deny that Participant’s entry into FEEcon Events.
4. FEE Credentials allow the Participant entry to specific defined events, but cannot guarantee admission to every FEEcon event. Event admission is subject to capacity and age restrictions in compliance with state and local laws. Age restrictions and capacity are specific to each venue. I understand that if I am under the age of 18, my parent/guardian approves of my attendance to FEEcon.
5. Tampering with any Credentials, or Wristbands (e.g., stretching, tearing, cutting, tapping, etc.) is not permitted. If tampering is evident, the applicable Credential or Wristband will be invalidated and confiscated and Participant will not be allowed entry to any/all FEEcon venues and Events where the Credential or Wristband is required.
6. Lost and Found will be located at Registration during the Events. Participants

can drop off found items at the Registration Help Desks during the Events. Participants can also email a description of an item and the location it was lost/found to [feecon@fee.org](mailto:feecon@fee.org). FEE is not responsible for damaged or lost items dropped off at the Registration Help Desks during the Events. After ninety (90) days following the event, unclaimed lost and found items may be disposed of in FEE's discretion.

7. Photographs and/or audio/video recordings taken at the Events by FEE, or others on behalf of FEE, may include a Participant's image, name, voice and/or likeness. By attending and/or participating in the Events, each Participant hereby grants FEE permission to use, and to sublicense to third-parties, the Participant's photograph, image, likeness, voice and statements for any purpose, including but not limited to commercial purposes, without compensation or credit to the Participant, in any and all media now known or hereafter devised.

8. Event Participants agree to the FEE Code of Conduct. FEE is not a place for behavior that is intentionally inappropriate, off-topic, disruptive, or abusive. FEEcon is a private event and FEE reserves the right, without refund, to revoke the Credentials of Participants whose conduct violates the Code of Conduct.

9. Each Participant understands that participating in the Events is voluntary and may involve certain risks of physical injury, damage to property, and other damages or losses that may be sustained by a Participant. Each Participant assumes all risk of damages, property loss, and personal injury which may occur by participating in the Events.

10. IN NO EVENT SHALL FEE BE LIABLE TO ANY PARTICIPANT, OR ANY OTHER PERSON OR ENTITY FOR ANY PERSONAL INJURY OR DAMAGES TO PROPERTY, DAMAGES FOR LOSS OF BUSINESS PROFITS OR OTHER PECUNIARY LOSS, INCLUDING ANY DIRECT, CONSEQUENTIAL, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, PUNITIVE OR SIMILAR DAMAGES, ARISING OUT OF ANY PARTICIPANT'S USE OF THE REGISTRATION, CREDENTIALS AND/OR PARTICIPATION IN THE EVENTS, EVEN IF FEE HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.

11. EXCEPT AS MAY BE EXPRESSLY SET FORTH IN THESE TERMS, PARTICIPANT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE EVENTS, AND ALL SERVICES AND PRODUCTS PROVIDED IN CONNECTION WITH THE EVENTS, ARE PROVIDED "AS IS" WITHOUT ANY WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, AND NO OTHER WARRANTIES, WHETHER EXPRESS, IMPLIED, OR OTHERWISE, ARE MADE WITH RESPECT TO THE SAME, INCLUDING ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE OR SAFETY, OR ANY WARRANTIES THAT MAY ARISE FROM COURSE OF DEALING. FEE EXPRESSLY DISCLAIMS ANY WARRANTIES NOT EXPRESSLY STATED HEREIN.

12. Each Participant (each an “Indemnifying Party”) agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold FEE and its officers, employees, volunteers, contractors, suppliers, and representatives harmless from and against any and all claims, demands and all other liabilities, including, but not limited to, costs and attorneys’ fees, made by any third party arising out of or in connection with the Indemnifying Party’s use of the registration(s) or Credentials, or any violation of the Terms by the Indemnifying Party.

13. The Terms will be governed by the laws of the State of Georgia, without regard to its principles of conflicts of laws. Each Participant and FEE hereby irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the United States federal and state courts located in Atlanta, Georgia and agrees that any such court will be the proper forum for the determination of any dispute arising hereunder.

14. FEE reserves the right to make changes to the Terms at any time without notice to each Participant, so please check back and review the Terms from time to time. In the event that any term or provision of the Terms shall be deemed invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, such term or provision shall be deemed severable and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining term or provision.
